Look Out For ...

Billy Bragg winds up his visit at the Galaxy on March 11 ... at Western Springs on March 14 at 8pm are **ZZ Top**, with two support acts — **Jimmy Barnes**, going on at 6.45pm, and locals **Knightshade** on at 6pm. Doors open at 4pm ... the **Damned** play Palmerston North's rock festival on March 28, then the Galaxy on the 29th ... the **Johnnys** embark on their sixth NZ tour, co-billed with fellow Australians **Paul Kelly** and the **Coloured Girls** at some gigs ...

Shriekback play Dunedin April 6, Chch 7, Wgton 9, Auckland 10 & 11 ... stand-up comics **Michael Winslow** and **George Smilovici** tour the main centres, with George carrying on to smaller towns ... from Britain to the Gluepot come **Travellers Czech**, a rock & roll cabaret on March 31, April 1 & 2 ... at the Gluepot on April 10 & 11 is an **International Jazz Spectacular** featuring top LA horn-men **Gary Grant** and **Bill Reichenbach**, backed by the **Rodger Fox Band**. They tour the rest of NZ in late

April ... on the local front, Orientation winds up with a **Mardi Gras** on March 8, while Auckland's **Fringe Festival** has a final concert at the Gluepot on March 11 ... and **When the Cat's Away** featuring Debbie Harwood, Kim Willoughby, Annie Crummer, Diane Swan and Margaret Ulrich, returns to the Gluepot on March 12 & 13.

Damned at Festival

The Damned have replaced China Crisis as the headliners at the Rheineck rock festival to be held

in Palmerston North on March 28. Also taking part are Australian bands the Johnnys, Paul Kelly and the Coloured Girls, plus locals Herbs, Dance Exponents, the Bats, the Pterodactyls, Three Leaning Men, Cement Garden and the End. The festival will run from 1pm till 11pm at the Palmerston North showgrounds, which has a new grandstand and terracing; if it rains the large Manawatu Sports Stadium will be used.
