When A Man Loves A Woman — The Ultimate Collection

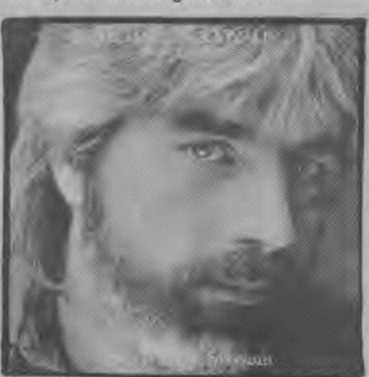

MICHAEL McDONALD

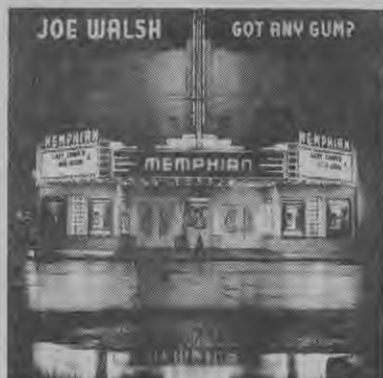
Sweet Freedom — Best of

GEORGE BENSON & EARL KLUGH

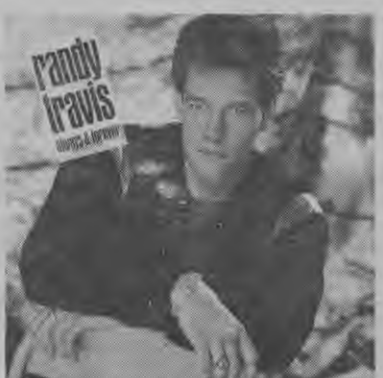

EMMYLOU HARRIS

Angel Band

One of ladies of Trio, not Dolly or Linda, but Emmylou. Here this highly regarded singer is teamed with Nashville veteran Emory Gordy Jr., to make an album of spiritual songs. All vocals were recorded live in the studio. A timeless collection of gospel recorded in a timeless manner.



NITTY GRITTY DIRT BAND

20 Years of Dirt, Best Of

This is the band's twentieth year of performing together. There are eleven masterful tracks here from 'Mr Bojangles' in 1969 to 'Stand a Little Rain' from last year. The Nitty Gritty Dirt Band sure are a mighty fine tradition.

Shirley Murdock!

A beauty album from Zapp man Roger Troutman's studio. The album has plenty of funky numbers but it was sleeper bedroom ballad 'As We Lay' that stormed up the USA black music charts. Powerful stuff from a great soul vocalist.
