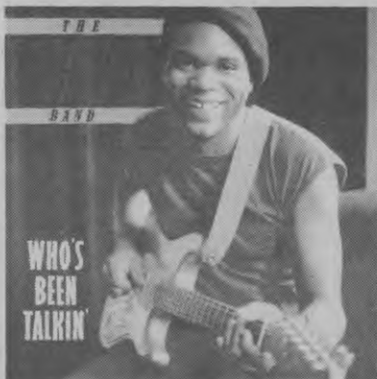




ECHO & THE BUNNYMEN

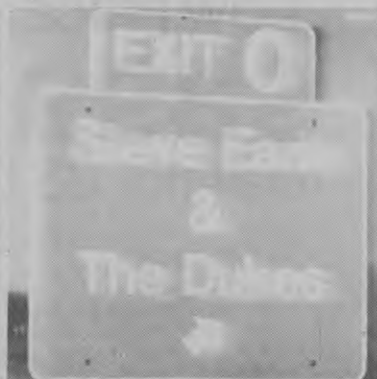
SAMMY HAGAR

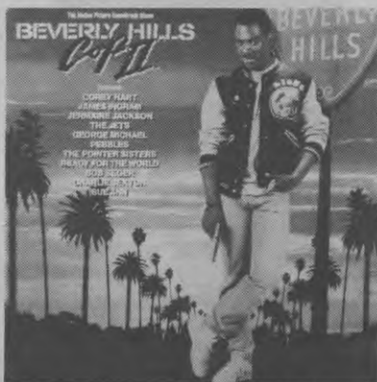
JENNY MORRIS

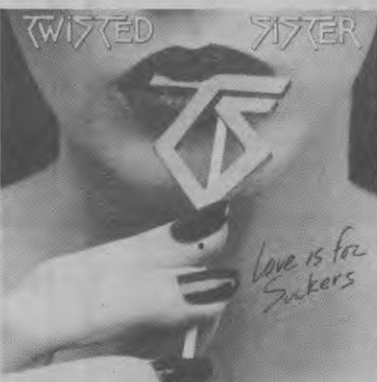
BEVERLY HILLS COP 2
