There will be no lack of entertainment for children over the Festival period. There are two free circuses for children and

adults. The first, Robinson's Family Circus, features traditional activities such as wild animals in captivity. The second circus is one with a difference — an amalgam of acrobats, dancers, mime artists, fire-eaters — who will put on a remarkable cabaret act.

In addition there are puppet shows and clowns. The children's area will have swings, maypoles, flying foxes, free merry-go-rounds, sand pits, painting facilities, slides and an adventure playground. Full creche facilities for pre-schoolers and a play tent to look after those slightly older.
