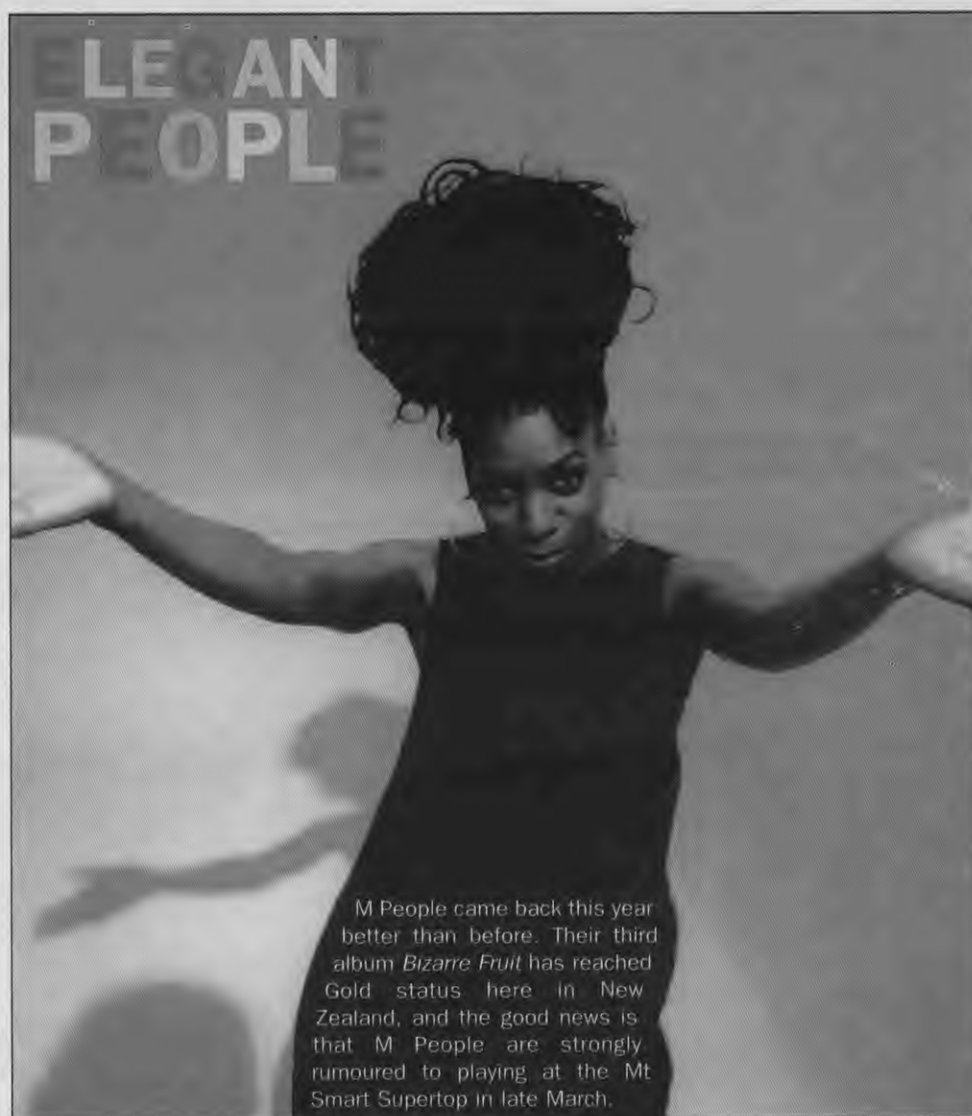
RIP IT UP!
