Papers, largely personal, of Richard B. Gore, closely associated with Sir James Hector in Geological Survey, and of his sons Henry M. (Hansard reporter) and Charles St. G. G. Gore (cricketer). Includes correspondence, accounts, genealogical information and photographs.

GRACE, John.

Papers, 1853-1886. 1 inch. Donation: Wilkinson, Nankervis and Stewart, Wellington.

Receipt for passage money to New Zealand by *Northfleet*; documents related to purchase of land at Wainuiomata, 1854-1886; Commission as Captain in Wellington Militia, 1863 and other official papers, newspaper clippings.
