appointed temporary ranger on a salary of 20s. per day to see that the injunction was obeyed. He took up residence on the island with his family, being relieved in February 1893. Shortly before his departure Wright made a fine series of plates showing with remarkable clarity the vegetation, coastline and native inhabitants of the island. Of particular interest are his views of the Maori settlement at Waitahurama, a locality for which no record survives but which was probably situated at Te Maraeroa. In all of these photographs Wright's delicate sense of composition and fine eye for
